2015 Mystery Quilt - POP STARS

Here are some fabric choices for the Pop Stars Mystery Quilt. Feel free to switch up the colors or use prints from your stash. The main thing I would suggest if you are going to use a lot of different fabrics is to keep the background fabric either white, a light cream or a very pale gray (not the gray I've included in the list below) color. The lighter the better. This will allow your other fabrics and prints to pop.

- If you plan to use a variety of fabrics (scrappy) be sure to get 2 yards of the white/cream fabric for your background. The rest of the colors you can play around with.
- If you are not using Northcott Colorworks fabrics and would like to use solids in your quilt just pick up any solids that match the color in parenthesis in the list below.
- If you do want to use the same fabrics I am using from the Northcott Colorworks collection I've included the fabric number and color to make it easier for you to find in your local quilt shop and online.

Northcott ColorWorks Premium Solids:

- 9000- 10 Snow (white): 2 yards
- 9000- 92 Smoke (gray): 1 yard
- 9000- 821 Thistle (purple): 1/4 yard
- 9000- 71 Lime (lime green): 1/4 yard
- 9000- 54 Daffodil (golden yellow or peach color will work): 1/8 yard
- 9000- 641 Lagoon (aqua): 5/8 yard + 5 yards for backing
- 9000- 201 Make Me Blush (light pink): 1/8 yard
- 9000- 28 Fuschia (hot pink): 7/8 yard
- 9000- 232 Coral (coral): 1/8 yard
- 9000- 380 Cinnabar (cinnamon or plum color will work): 1/8 yard
- 9000- 540 Canary (yellow): 1/8 yard
- 9000- 99 Black (black): 1/2 yard for binding

Other supplies needed:

- Sewing machine
- Rotary cutter + mat
- Ironing board + iron
- Fine straight pins or glue for basting
- Fabric marking pen or chalk
